

UNPACKING INSTRUCTION



STAND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Install the base of the stand on to, for example, a table top.
- 2. Attach the suspension arm link to the base stand
- 3. Tighten the nut once your preferred suspension arm direction has been determined
- 4. Attach the arm to the suspension arm link
- 5. Attach the shock mount to the suspension arm
- 6. Adjust the height of the arm to your preferred height
- 7. Put the microphone into the clamp ring of the shock mount
- 8. Optional: attach the pop filter to the stand to eliminate popping and sibilance sound
